A Day in the School Life of : Pupil 4 (30.1.24)

8.30am	Pupil 4 arrives early and makes their way into breakfast club. She is provided with breakfast and takes part in the activities run by BC staff.
8:45	On entry to school, completes 'fix it' maths problems from the previous day, supported in a small group by support staff while teacher hears readers and completes registration.
9:15	Takes part in the Destination Reader session to begin with led by class teacher. Enjoys hearing the story of The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane. Then works in a small group with TA3 on stage 8 phonics while teacher completes comprehension with remainder of the class.
10.00	Daily Mile - completes the daily mile supervised by support staff.
10.15	Maths - takes part in the lesson following the Red Rose Mastery programme. Follows the guided session well but finds concentrating in the independent session difficult. Is given focus prompts and support from Y4 TA /pastoral member.
11.00	Break time - is given free fruit to eat and plays with other children well. Supervised by Support staff.
11.15	English – completes a session based around planning a story looking at features of fantasy stories (class teacher)
12.20pm	Supervised at lunchtime with other children in the dining hall. Seeks support of member of pastoral staff when issue arises on the playground involving other children.
1.05	Completes RWI phonics intervention (support staff) while other children take part in newsround discussion. (Pupil 4 will take part in Newsround discussions on other afternoons) -
1.20	Completes Spanish activity with class teacher on vocab for naming parts of the body
2.00	Completes afternoon science session - based around sound.
3.00	Takes part in after school chess / games club run by teacher supported by member of pastoral staff.
