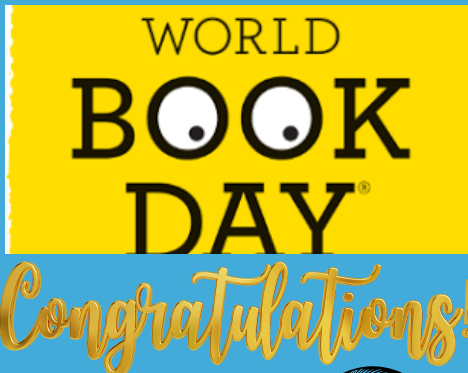
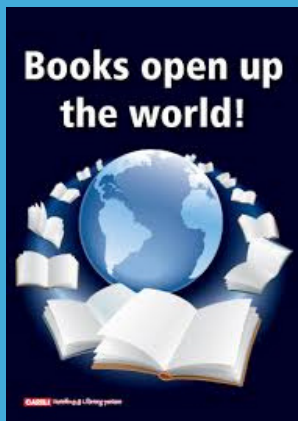

WORLD BOOK DAY

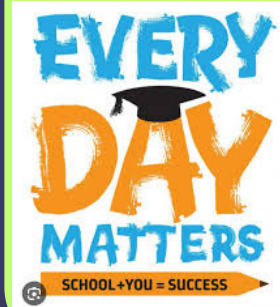
A message was sent out a couple of weeks ago about dressing up as a book character. Since then our reading ambassadors have met and have included dressing up as a word. So the children have a choice.
